

QUEENS' MARKETPLACE "KOKUA FOR KEIKI" PROGRAM Thursday, December 1, 2022, to Tuesday, January 31, 2023 PROGRAM RULES

PROGRAM OVERVIEW. *Kokua for Keiki* is a program between Queens' Marketplace ("Sponsor") and participating schools. The Kokua for Keiki donation will be awarded based on 15% of the total amount spent at Queens' Marketplace and submitted during the program period. At the end of the Program Period, the total donation is calculated based on amount spent.

PROGRAM PERIOD. Queens' Marketplace's *Kokua for Keiki Program* ("Program") begins on December 1, 2022, at 8:00 a.m. Hawaii Standard Time ("HST") and ends on January 31, 2023, at 11:59 p.m. HST ("Program Period"). Receipts dated between December 1, 2022, through January 31, 2023, are eligible. The donation will be awarded based on 15% of the total amount spent (excluding tax and gratuity). By participating in the Program, each participant unconditionally accepts and agrees to comply with and abide by these Official Rules (the "Official Rules"), and the decisions of A & B Properties Hawaii LLC ("Sponsor"), including the interpretation of these Official Rules, which will be final and binding in all respects.

PARTICIPATING SCHOOLS.

Waikoloa Elementary & Middle School

HOW TO SUBMIT A RECEIPT.

- 1. Participants in the Kokua for Keiki program must be Hawaii residents age 18+.
- 2. Qualifying receipts must be dated and submitted online between December 1, 2022, and January 31, 2023.
- 3. Visit queensmarketplace.com/kokuaforkeiki to be directed to the online form.
- 4. Participants will be required to fill out the online form that includes contact, email, phone, and zip
- 5. Participants will be required to upload a picture or copy of receipts and upload when prompted.
- 6. Submit form online once required fields have been completed.

ELIGIBILITY AND LIMITATIONS. The Program is open to legal residents of Hawaii who are 18 years of age or older. Each Participant in the Program agrees to be bound by these Official Rules and A & B Properties Hawaii LLC 's decisions made at its sole discretion. The Program is subject to all applicable federal, state, and local laws and regulations.

SUBMISSION RESTRICTIONS. Submissions become the sole property of Sponsor. Sponsor and its agencies are not responsible for late, lost, incomplete, illegible/garbled, inaccessible, damaged, or misdirected submissions, all of which are void. Sponsor is also not responsible for (a) programming, electronic, technological, telephonic, network or other malfunction, error, or failure which in any way affects or interferes with the operation of the Program or Queens' Marketplace web site itself or (b) any mechanical, programming, typographical, printing or other error of any kind affecting the Program.



WINNER DETERMINATION. On or about February 8, 2023, Sponsor will tally points and Participating Schools will receive donations based on points earned.

DONATIONS.

The donation will be awarded based on 15% of total receipt amounts submitted between December 1, 2022, through January 31, 2023. The school can receive a maximum donation of up to \$2,500.

DELIVERY OF DONATION(S): Participating Schools will receive notification and communication on how to receive donation(s).

LINKS TO THIRD PARTY SITES.

Queens' Marketplace's web site may link to other sites owned and operated by third parties and not maintained by Sponsor. Sponsor has no control over these linked sites, all of which have separate privacy and data collection practices and legal policies independent of Sponsor. Sponsor is not responsible for the contents of any linked sites and does not make any representations regarding the content or accuracy of material on such sites. Viewing such third-party sites is entirely at participants own risk. Participants are encouraged to be aware when they leave Queens' Marketplace web site and to read the privacy statements of any other site that collects personally identifiable information.

CONDITIONS OF PARTICIPATION. By accepting the donation, Participating School agrees to the use of its name and image for advertising/trade/publicity purposes by Sponsor and its designees without further compensation or notice. By participating in the program, Participants and Participating Schools releases and agrees to indemnify, defend, and hold harmless Sponsor, its parent, affiliates, subsidiaries, and their respective members, managers, directors, officers, employees and agents, from any and all liability arising from or related to the Program or acceptance, receipt or use/misuse of the donation. If Program cannot be conducted as originally planned due to any cause beyond Sponsor's control (e.g., computer virus or act of fraud), Sponsor may cancel/suspend/modify Program and allocate donations equally among all participating schools prior to and/or after action taken by Sponsor or otherwise in a manner determined by Sponsor in its sole discretion to be fair, appropriate and consistent with these Official Rules; Sponsor will notify Participating Schools of such action via email. Tampering with Program, Queens' Marketplace's web site, violation of these Official Rules or any attempt to defraud Sponsor will result in disqualification; but disqualification shall not represent the sole remedy available to Sponsor. Sponsor's failure to enforce any provision of these Rules is NOT a waiver of such provision. Any dispute or claim regarding the Program will be resolved pursuant to the laws of the State of Hawaii. Any such dispute/claim must be brought individually (NOT as part of a class action) in federal or state court in Honolulu, Hawaii with recovery being limited to one's actual costs in participating in the Program with all damages or other forms of recovery being expressly waived.
